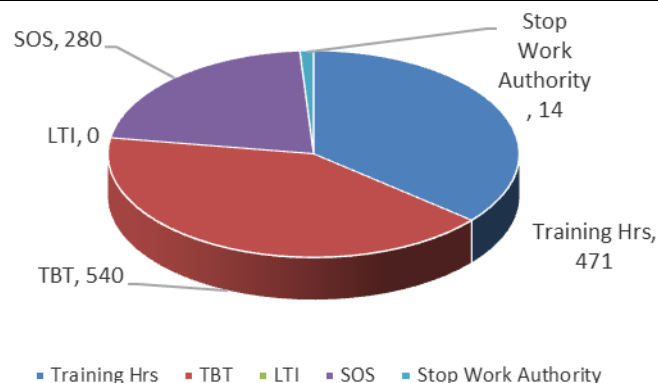

Driving Safety: Blind Corner

What is a Blind Corner?

A **blind corner** or **blind turn** is a corner on a road where the view of what is behind the corner is obstructed. Blind spots can be created by parked cars on the side of the road, buildings, materials, hills, trees or bushes.

Blind Corner Prevention at Workplace?

Convex Mirrors: Practical placement of Convex mirrors near the edge of blind corners will help to identify any vehicle approaching the intersection

Speed Limit: Reduction of speed limit will force the drivers/operators to slow down.

Placement of Signage's: Signage's can be posted near the blind corners to alert drivers/operators.

Continuous Reinforcement: Conduct regular toolbox and trainings with employees. Ensure all driving company vehicles have valid Defensive Driving Training Certificates.

Blind Corner Prevention outside Workplace?

Slow Down: Slow down your vehicle and check for any vehicles or pedestrians at blind corners. Even if you have the right of way common sense suggests that you take practical steps to keep yourself away from harm

Be Vigilant: Have complete focus on roads specially near high traffic zones such as residential areas, offices, industrial areas, schools, shopping centers etc. and slow down.
