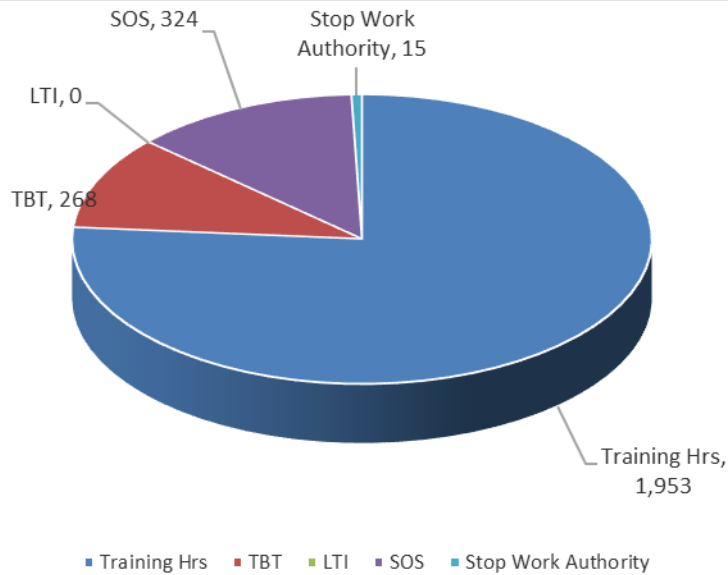

Line of Fire

Line of Fire is being in harms way. Line of fire injuries occur when the path of a moving object and an individual's body intersect

Examples of Line of Fire

-  In the path of the moving Object
-  Underneath lifted load objects that could fall
-  Working next to unstable materials that could shift
-  Working next to object under tension/ released energy
-  Placing hands or body in equipment that can rotate

Actions to be taken to Control Hazards

- Engineering Controls**
Provide physical barriers e.g. equipment guards, guardrails, enclosure etc. to isolate the person from the hazard.
- Secure**
Secure all materials with correct tensioned lines such as cables, ropes and chains. Use whip check arrestors to prevent high pressure lines from hitting persons when inadvertently disengaged. Use wedges to prevent inadvertent movement of vehicles and pipes.
- Barricade & Signages**
Barricade hazardous/ potentially hazardous areas where harm can take place. Provide proper signages to create awareness
- Inspection**
Inspect visually all lifting gears, safety belts and materials for any damages before employing them for any task.
- Awareness**
Be aware of your surroundings and hazards you might be exposed to. Be aware of blind spots while working near vehicles. Conduct awareness sessions e.g. TBT, trainings etc.
