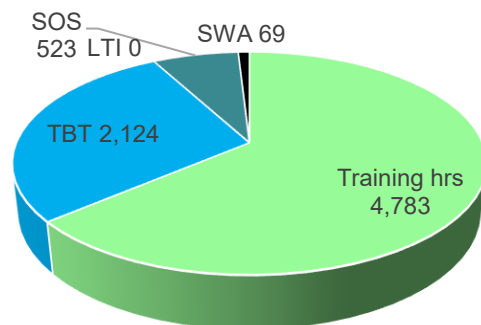

INTERNATIONAL OVERDOSE AWARENESS DAY

Date: 31 August 2026

Theme: "25 Years On. Still Needed."

Substance misuse can impair concentration, judgment, coordination and reaction time, placing the individual and others at serious risk. Never report to work, operate equipment or drive while impaired. Take medication only as prescribed and inform the appropriate occupational-health representative if it may affect safe work performance. - World Health Organization

RUSHING RISKS SAFETY

Rushing at work risks caused by inadequate planning, operational demands, deadlines, delays, shift changes or unexpected conditions can reduce concentration and encourage unsafe shortcuts. Time pressure must never result in skipped safety checks, improper tool use, poor coordination or deviation from approved procedures. If sufficient time or resources are unavailable, stop the task, make the area safe, inform the supervisor and reschedule the work.

WHAT CAN HAPPEN WHEN WORK IS RUSHED?

- ❖ Hazards are missed and judgment declines
- ❖ Tools, equipment and energy isolation are misused
- ❖ Line-of-fire, lifting and driving risks increase
- ❖ Injuries, damage and equipment failures occur
- ❖ Rework, investigations and delays follow

FACTORS THAT CAN LEAD TO RUSHING



Precautions:

- ✓ Confirm the work scope, sequence and hazards before starting.
- ✓ Plan and coordinate adequate time, personnel, permits, tools, materials, equipment, training and supervision.
- ✓ Correct unsafe site conditions; stop, reassess and revise the plan whenever conditions change.

ORGANIZATIONAL FACTORS



Precautions:

- ✓ Establish realistic schedules with safety as the priority.
- ✓ Provide proper planning, competent manpower and supervision.
- ✓ Review and reschedule the activity whenever necessary.
- ✓ Communicate that no deadline justifies unsafe work.
- ✓ Encourage reporting and the use of Stop Work Authority.

PERSONNEL FACTORS



Precautions:

- ✓ Take the required rest, remain focused and report unfitness for work.
- ✓ Follow the JSA and maintain awareness throughout the task.
- ✓ Follow the correct work sequence without taking shortcuts.
- ✓ Seek instructions and perform only authorized work.
- ✓ Ask for assistance whenever additional support is required.
- ✓ Follow approved procedures and use Stop Work Authority.

Before starting or continuing the task, ask:

- P – Plan:** Is the work properly planned and understood?
- A – Assess:** Have all hazards and changing conditions been assessed?
- U – Use:** Are the correct tools, equipment, PPE, and manpower available?
- S – Stop:** Am I rushing, fatigued, distracted, or under time pressure?
- E – Execute safely:** Can the job be completed safely within the available time?
